Main Duties

1. To support Nursing and Nursing Associate students undertaking an apprenticeship.

- 7. To act as a Personal Academic Tutor to Nursing / Nursing Associate students.
- 8. To participate in the recruitment of students, including selection events and open days.
- 9. To support meetings as required to represent the Apprenticeship Office and wider university.
- 10. To gather information from a variety of sources e.g. practice learning evaluations, individual learner reviews etc. and by working with academics and practice partners ensure that the data is accurate and ready for regulatory body inspections.
- 11. To participate fully in the life of the School and University by engaging in representational and ambassadorial activities in support of the School's activities and carry out any other reasonable duties as requested by the Head of School or his/her nominee.
