## **Main Duties**

1. Carry out objectives of the project.

- 2. Conduct research independently but also in collaboration with teams at Virginia Tech.
- 3. Write or contribute to publications or disseminate research findings using media appropriate to the discipline.
- 4. Make presentations at conferences or exhibit work in other appropriate events.
- 5. Supervise postgraduate research students.
- 6. Routinely communicate research findings in the group and with collaborators.
- 7. Plan, co-ordinate and implement research programmes.
- 8. Develop productive working relationships with other members of staff.
- 9. Coordinate the work of colleagues to ensure equitable access to resources and facilities.
- 10. Deal with standard problems and help colleagues resolve their concerns about progress in research.
- 11. Assess, interpret and evaluate outcomes of research.
- 12. Resolve problems of meeting research objectives and deadlines.
- 13. Decide on research programmes and methodologies, often in collaboration with colleagues and sometimes subject to the approval of the head of the research programme on fundamental issues.
- 14. Balance the pressures of research and administrative demands and competing deadlines.
- 15. Be aware of the risks in the work environment and their potential impact on their own work and that of others.
- 16. Depending on area of work (eg laboratories) take responsibility for conducting risk assessments, and take responsibility for the health and safety of others and reducing hazards.

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- 17. Knowledge of, and adherence to, the University's policies and procedures.
- 18. Maintain personal and professional development to meet the changing demands of the job; participate in appropriate training activities and encourage and support staff in their development and training.
- 19. Take steps to ensure and enhance personal health, safety and wellbeing and that of other staff and students.
- 20. Carry out these duties in a manner that promotes equality of opportunity and supports diversity and inclusion, and takes into account the University's commitment to environmentally sustainable ways of working.
