Main Duties*:	
1. To provide a safe, fun, learning environment for all campers with challenging and engaging coaching sessions.	
2. To ensure the safe movement of campers between campuses, adhering to health and safety procedures outlined in the risk assessment.	
3. To ensure all campers in your block / flat are awake and ready for breakfast.	
4. To ensure all campers in your block / flat are in their rooms ready for bed at the agreed time.	
5. To report all injuries to camp sports therapists.	
6. To carry out miscellaneous duties required by the Camp Director.	
7. To educate players on injury prevention.	
8. Maintain personal and professional development to meet the changing demands of the job; participate in appropriate training activities and encourage and support staff in their development and training.	
9. Take steps to ensure and enhance personal health, safety, and well-being and that of other staff and students.	
10. Carry out these duties in a manner that promotes equality of opportunity and supports diversity and inclusion and takes into account the University's commitment to environmentally sustainable ways of working.
