| 7. | Experience of working with, and communicating research to, sectors outside of academia (examples may include, but are not limited to, the heritage sector; charitable organisations and the third sector; primary/secondary education; the media; policymakers; local and national government; the civil service). | Essential | Supporting Statement / Interview |
| 8. | Experience of active engagement with relevant academic networks and/or dissemination of research at conferences. | Essential | Supporting Statement / Interview |
| 9. | Ability to work independently and as a member of a team. | Essential | Interview |
| 10. | Excellent competency in IT for research purposes. | Essential | Interview |

Application Form – assessed against the application form and where appropriate, curriculum vitae. Applicants will
not be asked to answer a specific supporting statement. Normally used to evaluate factual evidence e.g. award of
a qualification. Will be "scored" as part of the shortlisting process.

 Supporting Statements - applicants are asked to provide a statement to demonstrate how they meet the criteria. The response will be "scored" as part of the shortlisting process.

 Interview – assessed during the interview process by either competency-based interview questions, tests, workrelated exercise, presentation, or teaching session etc.
